NOTES

- (1) This requisition must define the parcel of land by means of a map drawn to scale sufficient to enable such parcel to be identified accurately in the Statutory Charges Map or by other means which are sufficient for that purpose.
- (2) A separate requisition must be lodged in respect of each parcel of land except when the search is to be made in respect of two or more contiguous parcels of land for the same purpose.
- (3) Every map accompanying the requisition should be furnished in duplicate unless the map is not required to be returned.
- (4) This requisition may be sent by post to the Registrar of Titles, Land Registers, Statutory Charges Registry, Lanyon Plaza, Lanyon Place, Belfast, BT1 3LP or delivered personally to that office and must be accompanied by a fee of £25. Cheques should be made payable in favour of the Department of Finance and Personnel General Account.
