Can you please confirm if there is asbestos in the old courier headquarter building (Centralised Transport Unit) beside annexe 6+7 which the courier staff were based in, if so what date was it discovered, what date were the staff moved out to the new office in Stormont Castle and could I have any e-mails which would cover this period from health and safety/management etc! regarding asbestos.
- 2. Could you please tell me what type of asbestos was discovered in the building.

Response

- There is asbestos in the old courier headquarter building (Centralised Transport Unit). It was discovered in May 2003 and remains in-situ. There was an additional discovery of fuse flashguards in December 2016 which were removed in August 2021.
 - Courier Staff moved to the Stormont Castle Stables complex on Monday 9 October 2017. The Department does not hold any e-mails from Health and Safety or management regarding asbestos over this period.
- 2. The type of asbestos discovered in the building is chrysotile.
