 The Department can confirm that it holds the information requested. The table below lists the number¹ of domestic/mixed² properties that benefited from a relief or allowance in the 2022/23 rating year by relief or allowance category.

Lone Pensioner Allowance includes, Housing Benefit for Owner Occupiers, and Housing Benefit/Low Income Rate Relief for Private Tenants who have chosen a credit on their rate account (Social Sector is not included). Low Income Rate Relief refers to Low Income Rate Relief for Owner Occupiers only (does not include Social Sector). Rate Rebate Scheme includes Owner Occupiers, Private Tenants and Social Sector.

2. The total number of distinct domestic/mixed properties that benefited from one or more relief or allowance in the 2022/23 rating year was 471,194. This figure is different from the total of the table above as some properties receive more than one relief/allowance. The totals include those with no rates to pay as well as reduced liabilities.
